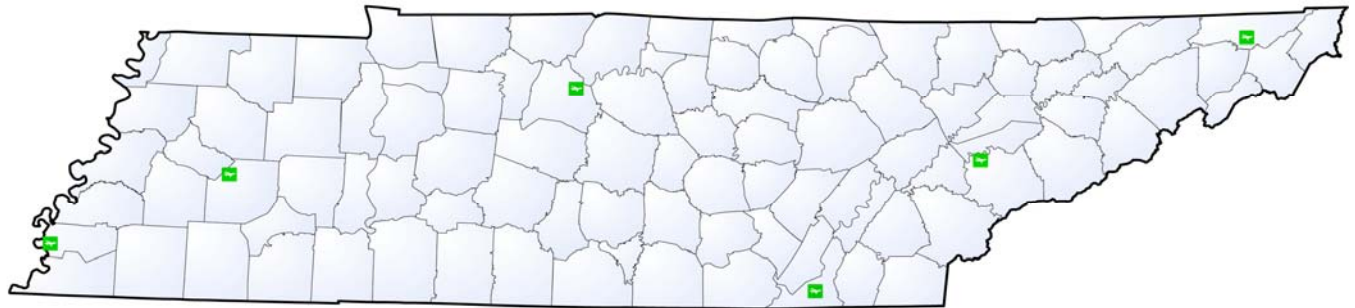


Tennessee Airports

Tennessee Commercial Service Airports



Commercial Service Airports (Longest Runway)

- Memphis International Airport (11,120')
- Nashville International Airport (11,030')
- McGhee Tyson Airport, Knoxville (9,005')
- Tri-Cities Regional Airport, Bristol-Johnson City-Kingsport (8,000')
- Chattanooga Metropolitan Airport (7,400')
- McKellar-Sipes Regional Airport, Jackson (6,006')

General Aviation Airports

- Tennessee has 74 public/general aviation airports.
- There are also 126 heliports in the state.

Cargo Capabilities

- All six commercial airports have invested heavily in new cargo-handling infrastructure.
- Memphis International is a central hub for FedEx and is the biggest transporter of cargo in the world.
